C. CAP updates:

95-2022-502 Blue Ridge Conservancy – Riparian Buffer/Stream

Getting design finalized and construction should begin in spring. Preliminary design done by engineers.

95-2024-501 New River Conservancy (at Green Valley Park). Waiting on sealed designs from engineers. Erosion issues. They are to do spring planting.

8. Brian Bonville:

Bonville attended the HUAP training in Ashe County. He also attended the Wells for Livestock training in Wilkes on 11/18/25. Bonville was invited and attended the Meet Your Local Government on October 26th held in the Ag Conference Center.

9. NRCS Samantha Dame

NRCS had wanted all EWP site visits to be complete by 11-1-25. The NRCS was having a morning meeting at the same time as the Board meeting. Ms. Dame to get timeframe once she gets an update. NRCS is in the review stage. They are converting paperwork for review by Supervisors. Application deadline is January 15, 2026. Bonville stated that at the County Commissioners meeting the RFQ went out and they decided to split the EWP projects between two contractors, Breck & Brushy Fork.

10. RC&D Report –Jessica Janc

There is a stream planting project at the Jensen's farm after Thanksgiving. Bonville stated that he was out there recently and the wild flower seed that was planted has come up.

Janc stated that they are holding a Live Stake training soon. They also have a project at Angler Park. Blue Ridge RC&D will be doing the live stake giveaway in late winter in Ashe, Wilkes, Alleghany and Watauga.

Bonville asked if she had heard about the Grant from Trout Unlimited. They are giving away 7500 5-gallon trees. They prefer to drop 100 at a time. Jessica Janc stated that Ashe was doing a tree giveaway during the live stake giveaway. Just in case another county might be interested in doing the same.

11. Division Report – Elise McLaughlin

No report.

12. Admin Report: Michelle Kasey

Kasey stated that so far there has been no interest in the Speech Contest. Did the Board still want to host a contest night for the Poster Winners?

Denny Norris stated that yes, they had done that in the past and a lot of parents had shown up for it.

Kasey stated that she attended a zoom meeting for the Buildfest planning – event to be held in April. We are doing seedbombs at our station.

Kasey stated that we now have 2 Envirothon teams – one High School and one Middle School.

Kasey also stated that there were now 5 classes participating in the poster contest. These are classrooms that previously did not compete. Valle Crucis school usually has two teams, but that school just opened.

13. Bonny Bonville told the Board that he was planning on attend the Blue Ridge Women in Ag's event – Farming on Leased Land Friday 11/21/25 from 4-6pm. This event is good for young farmers.

14. Denny Norris asked Bill Moretz to help him do the Employee Annual Reviews for Bonville and Kasey since there is no Co-Chair. Kasey to find out due date and communicate with both Norris and Moretz.
